In all uses, the photographer will be credited with the work.
3. In the event that models/persons/inadvertent individuals appear in the photograph entry, I hereby declare that the recruitment and use of such persons and likeness are with their full written consent, or if they are younger than 18, the written consent of their legal guardian; thereby relinquishing claims made by or compensation sought by such persons. Please include releases with your submission.
4. I have met all rules and regulation published in this contest.

RULES:

1. The contest is open to everyone except employees of the PHMC and Anthracite Heritage Museum and Iron Furnaces Associates, its board and other compensated personnel.
2. The theme is Anthracite Heritage and the photographer is encouraged to capture images that show subjects related to regional history. These could be landscapes, buildings, portraits, memorials, street signs, or even selfies taken in a heritage setting.
3. The photographs that demonstrate the best composition but do not win the contest, will be included in the upcoming *Anthracite Photographers: Photographers of Anthracite* exhibit scheduled to open late Fall 2018 at the Anthracite Heritage Museum. The winning photographs will be matted and framed and included prominently in the exhibit. At the close of the exhibit the matted and framed photos will be returned to the photographer.
4. Photographs size submitted: 8 x 10 unmatte. Photographers are required to submit a digital copy or negative of the image. Please include a caption to describe the photo.
5. Photographs submitted are not returnable and all entries shall remain the property of Anthracite Heritage Museum who retains the right to reproduce, publish or exhibit them without notification or payment to the Photographer. In all uses, the photographer will be credited with the work.
6. A release must be submitted for each person/model (reference 3 above).
7. Photographs submitted for the contest must not have won prizes in any other contest or published elsewhere.
8. Photographers may submit as many entries (\$5 per entry) as they wish and the photograph must demonstrate some facet of Anthracite history or heritage. Special rates for HS school groups. Call for details.
9. One winner will be selected from the under 18 category and one from the over 18 category. Prints will be judged on the basis of composition, clarity, and content. Photographs must not be edited or retouched beyond minimal cropping, contrast and brightness. Composite photographs, photo montages, trick photographs, or subject to digital image manipulation or super imposition are not permitted.
10. The decision of the judges is final and no queries on the results will be entertained.
